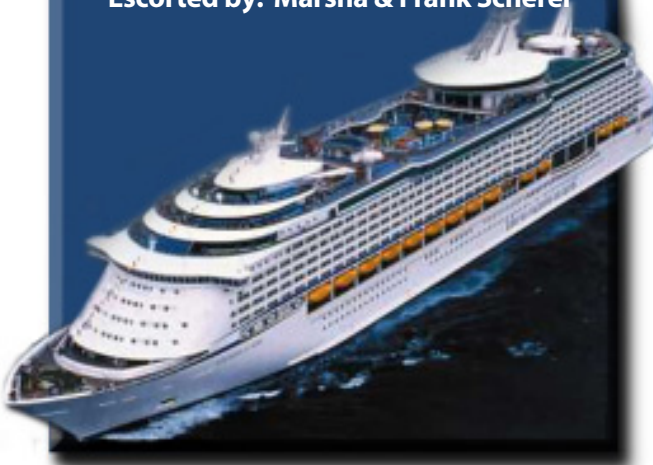

King's Wharf Bermuda: King's Wharf has something for everyone. Sample typical island food and stroll through the shops and museums of the Royal Naval Dockyard, an impressive military fortress built in 1815. Sail the clear waters of Hamilton Sound. Find quaint gems at the Bermuda Arts Center and Craft Market. If that's not enough, a snorkel park and watersport facility offer hours of activities to the adventuresome. Expect Great weather while in Bermuda. In June the Average High is 82 and the Average Low 74.

Philipsburg, St. Maarten: When the Spanish closed their colonial fort on St. Maarten in 1648, a few Dutch and French soldiers hid on the island and decided to share it. Soon after, the Netherlands and France signed a formal agreement to split St. Maarten in half, as it is today. Philipsburg displays its Dutch heritage in its architecture and landscaping. The island offers endless stretches of beach, beautiful landscapes and great shopping.

Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas: St. Thomas is known as an idyllic vacation spot today, but its history is not so peaceful. In the 18th century, the island was at the center of a bustling pirate culture, as swashbuckling pirates such as Blackbeard and Drake traded stolen wares in the port of Charlotte Amalie. This world-renowned Caribbean island is home to amazing beaches, gorgeous sea and landscapes and unbelievable duty-free shopping.

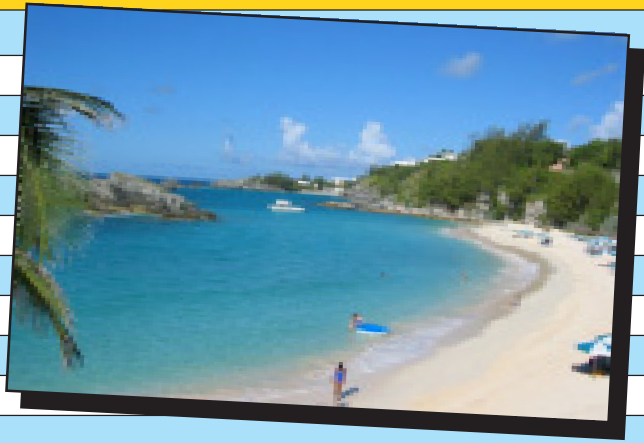

At the same time San Juan, the capital of the commonwealth, is a big city with a bustling business district, glitzy resorts and casinos, as well as one of the most stunning examples of colonial life in the Western world.

OUR SPECIAL POST CRUISE TOURS: **New York City:** The most popular part of New York City is area between Columbus Circle and Battery Park. Within those borders are some of the world most famous places: The Empire State Building, Chinatown, the World Trade Center Site, Grand Central Terminal, The United Nations, The Brooklyn Bridge, South Street Seaport, Washington Square Arch, Rockefeller Center and Times Square. With our private guide we will see, hear and explore New York City. During our tour we will enjoy lunch at Angelo's Pizza where we will enjoy NY-style Pizza. Angelo's Pizza is located next door to the Ed Sullivan Theatre, home to "The Late Show with David Letterman". We will end our tour on top of NYC, at the Top of the Rock Observation Deck. Washington DC: After enjoying a full breakfast buffet we will start our day at the Washington Monument, one of the tallest masonry structures in the world. This majestic obelisk was dedicated in 1885 to the memory of our first President. The Travel Masters have reserved a timed entry in to the monument. We will start our day in DC like we ended it in NYC . . . with a 360° view of the city. Following our visit to the top of Washington Monument we will enjoy a Guided City Tour of Washington DC which will include: The National World War II Memorial, The Vietnam Veterans Memorial, The Lincoln Memorial, The Korean War Veterans Memorial. Drives by the White House, The Capitol, Ford's Theater and the Peterson House (other sites as time permits). Following our city tour we will enjoy a late lunch at Ben's Chili Bowl.
